Copyright	Please be respectful of all copyrights and property of others.
Visually Appealing	Use a nice blend of images and text, following the guidelines from the Nearpod assignment "6 Tips to Improve Your Presentation"
Lesson Time	Please plan for at least 30 – 40 minutes of content
Strong and Clear Objectives	Make sure to follow the guidelines from the Nearpod assignment "Great Lessons Begin with Measureable Objectives and follow the objective format and use strong verbs.
Hook Activity	Make sure to follow the guidelines from the Nearpod assignment "Great Lessons Begin with Engaging Hooks". Ensure they are short, energetic and optimistic, and provide a smooth transition.
Content Slides	You should have at least 12-15 content slides and include images to support the text.
Interactive Assessments	One for every 3-4 slides of content. They should become progressively more challenging than the previous one.
Videos	Include at least 1 short video
Weblinks	Include at least 1 weblink
Introduction to Videos or Weblinks	Each weblink and video needs a slide to introduce it with description and the expected outcome.
Analog activity	Provide an opportunity for a time where the students “step away” from the device and collaborate.
Exit Quiz	Create an exit quiz using the interactive features.
Thank You Slide	Always end your session with a Thank You slide.
Teacher’s Notes / Resources	Be sure to include teacher's notes and / or links to resources.
Credit	Include a slide to list all sources you used in the lesson if they are not your own.
Personalized Learning Principles	Ways you will include or support at least 4 of the following: voice & choice, just-in-time instruction, flexible pacing, co-plan learning, and varied strategies.
